

The Rebel Submarine Ram CSS "Pioneer"

Legend:

A: Compartment for compressed air

B: Compartment for water

C: Cast iron bow and stern

D: Pilot house

F: Fins moved by the lever "N"

G: Levers by which torpedo was released

H: Pump for pumping water in / out of "B"

KK: Platform on which torpedoes rest while being secured to ship's bottom

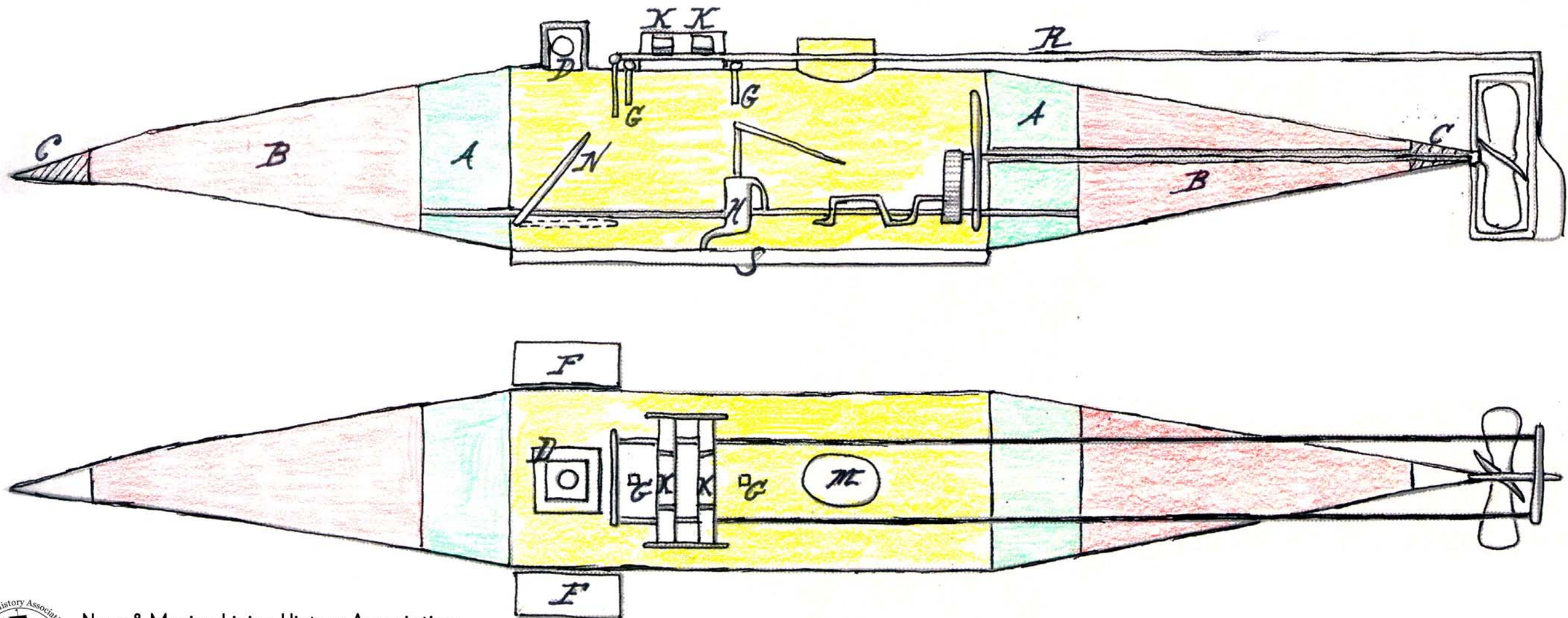
M: Manhole plate

R: Arrangement for working the rudder

S: Keel formed of five bars of railroad iron

Length 35 feet, width 4 feet.
